Grant Purpose	This grant is to develop work stations that allow our students to work on a vertical plane to support development of postural and upper extremity skill and endurance they will need to work efficiently in more traditional table top orientation.
Grant Activities	Teachers impacted by this grant will assist in locating activities and developing data collection appropriate for their students. Most tasks will be those that can be utilized on a vertical surface. A few will be transitional table top tasks selected to work on bilateral hand use. Activities will include both traditional paper and marker types of tasks and those utilizing manipulatives to work on sequencing, patterning or matching with material presented on a vertical surface.
