Grant Purpose	Selby Gardens will give students in grades kindergarten and first the opportunity to see animal and plant interdependence in a hands on setting. The exploration will provide students at a Title I school the chance to explore a facility in their own hometown that has so many educational resources. As part of the school improvement plan, 'students are provided learning opportunities in an environment that reflects community, culture, values, and needs'.
Grant Activities	Grant funds will be used for admission for students into Selby Gardens, including a Selby instructed and guided exploration on the butterfly and plant interdependence. The funds will directly benefit the students real world understanding of the effects of human interactions on plant and animal life. Funds are also used for transportation costs and chaperone costs.
Grant Budget Items	Funds will be used for travel costs on buses transporting students to and from Selby Gardens. Other costs include admission to Selby Gardens at \$7.00 a student. The funds will be directly paid to Selby and to the transportation company.
After Grant Plans	

	Grant activities will be continuous, both before and after the Selby visit. Students will be immersed in learning about animals through literature, such as Eric Carle books on butterflies and their metamorphosis, and on writing and kinesthetic activities, including learning the movements of the butterfly as it relates to it's survival in it's habitat. Students will be given additional curriculum in nature through our summer Eagle Academy, which includes a science club in the afternoons.
