CHAPTER 6.00 – PERSONNEL

LICENSE OF SCHOOL BUS DRIVER OPERATOR

6.172

Each school bus driver operator shall possess the minimum qualifications prescribed in Florida Statutes, State Board of Education rules, and other controlling regulations.

- All school bus drivers operators shall hold a valid Commercial Driver's License for a Class B vehicle with passenger (P) and school bus (S) endorsements.
- If the license shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the school bus or shall be carried by the driver operator while operating the bus.
- III Any driver who knowingly operates a school bus with a suspended or revoked license shall be subject to dismissal.

Any school bus operator who should have known that his/her driver's license has expired or has been suspended or revoked and who drives a bus shall be subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.
