Grant Description

Grant Objective- Relationship to school's SIP

Celebrating Cultural Diversity through the Arts is a project designed to create a showcase of the school population's ethnic and cultural diversity proudly expressed through the arts. It is a celebration of our rich and diverse heritage as seen through the students' eyes, and articulated through student creativity in visual arts, music, dance and performing arts. Our School Improvement Plan (SIP) Writing goal states that as of 2012, 90% of our students in grade 4 will demonstrate a 4.0 or higher on the writing essay in all subgroup populations and 85% of our students will make annual learning gains. Also, our (SIP) Reading goal states that 80% of our students in grades 3-5 will achieve reading proficiency (FCAT Level 3) in all subgroup populations and 73% of our students will make annual learning gains. This project will help our students improve their reading and writing scores.

Grant program activities (what is going to be done with the grant funds):

Throughout the year, students will use multi-media resources to research the artistic heritage of one culture at the time; create artwork that represents each cultural heritage; write about their work and its relationship to the ethnic heritage; critique projects in class using critical thinking strategies by comparing and contrasting the art, music and dances of different cultures; prepare their art work for exhibits around the school campus; develop written and oral communication for public speaking during the showcase; Prepare presentations for multi-cultural appearances that feature their research and artwork on the school Eagle Eye News Show.
