Grant Purpose	The purpose of this grant is to expose students to their local environment through an interdisciplinary unit. The theme of the unit will be understanding how human activity can have an impact on the world's oceans. Brookside Middle school is an IB school, filtering into Riverview's IB program. This unit will support Brookside's SIP because the lessons will integrate the core content areas, while also drawing on aspects of the IB Middle Years Program.
Grant Activities	Grant funds will be used to take students on a cost-free field trip to Mote Marine Aquarium. While there students will view the Sea Debris art exhibit currently on display from Washed Ashore, an organization that uses art to educate the public about the impacts of human activity on the world's oceans. Students will also participate in a classroom activity where they will learn how scientists track and study sea life. They will also learn about the local aquatic ecosystem.
Grant Budget Items	Student admission costs (\$16 per student) and transportation costs to and from the aquarium.
After Grant Plans	Teachers and students will organize a campus and possible beach cleanup to eliminate trash that could end up in the local waterways. Students will gather and analyze data about the trash collected and turn their findings into their own art displays to bring awareness to the growing problem of trash in the oceans. Students will be asked to write IB reflection reports about their experiences.
