The purpose of this proposal is to improve the safety of students walking and/or biking to and from Alta Vista Elementary school by providing improved infrastructure near the school, and by implementing a program to educate and encourage more students to safely walk or bike to and from school. This meets the *NeXt Generation* pillar of "Safety."

Briefly list **grant program activities** *(what is going to be done with the grant funds):*

If funded, the City of Sarasota will receive \$95,300 to install new and improved infrastructure along streets surrounding Alta Vista, and off school property, so that it is safer for students to walk or bike to school. \$24,650 will be used by the school for education, encouragement and enforcement activities, including a Bike Rally, Walk to School Days, curricular and educational materials, flyers, and a Walking Buddies program.

Please provide a **brief** explanation of pertinent **budget items** that will be funded through this grant. *(Please indicate if funds will be used for new/old staff position, contracted services, travel, materials/supplies, equipment/furniture, facilities, and other applicable items.)*

The majority of funds (approx. \$95,300) will be provided by the funder directly to the City of Sarasota for sidewalk widening and gap closures, and installing traffic calming devices, upgraded traffic signals, flashing beacons, pedestrian countdown signals, and pedestrian-activated signal upgrades. This portion of the grant will be managed exclusively by the City. Remaining funds, \$24,650 will be used by the school for teacher stipends, printing, educational materials, promotional materials, and guest speakers.

How will grant activities be continued after the end of grant period?

Once infrastructure grants are expended, new infrastructure will be in place and will be maintained by the City. The education and encouragement activities may be continued with school funds, or the program will end.
