Grant Purpose	"Pathway To Professionalism" will be a seventeen-week, after-school activity which will introduce a variety of film-and-video professionals to the students who are eager to work in the visual-entertainment industry. The project, which will be open to all high-school juniors and seniors (as well as adult students) on two campuses, will lead the students through the processes of conceiving, writing, pre-producing, shooting, editing, and marketing a short, narrative film.
Grant Activities	"Pathways To Professionalism" will combine the Digital Video Technology program's instructors with local, professional filmmakers to lead students through the entire filmmaking process and will introduce the professionals to the aspiring, student filmmakers. The funds will be used primarily to pay local professionals a modest honorarium for their time and efforts in educating the students, with the rest of the funds being used to buy expendable gear for the filmmaking process.
