Grant Purpose	We are coordinating with North Port HS to prepare students for the rigorous advanced classes offered by their Cambridge/AICE program. Many of our student come from homes where parents are not familiar with the pathway to college. Our population is 73% free/reduced lunch, and we have a sizable immigrant population. We want to prepare more of our students for the opportunity of a college educ., which will also raise test scores, and we want to attract back students who have gone to charter school
Grant Activities	Transportation & 12 substitutes for tour of FGCU,\$1750 Promotional t-shirts & bumper stickers, \$2300 Transportation - spring field trip to Key West for Cambridge life science, \$1550 Training for 9 new Cambridge teachers \$2250 Summer orientation with field trip \$2150 Cambridge Training for 9 new teachers \$2250
Grant Budget Items	The purpose of the grant to is help promote and enhance our Cambridge program. Transportation accounts for a little over a third of the budget. There is another \$650 for substitutes to free teachers for college and spring field trip. There is a \$1000 for stipends for 4 teachers for 2-day summer orientation, \$2300 for promotional materials (t-shirts & stickers), & \$2250 to train new teachers to expand program next year.

After Grant Plans	This will be the 2nd summer orientation. Both this orientation and college visits will be an on-going part of the program. So will field trips to enrich our students often limited experiences. We hope to grow our program each year to capacity. We have another program, SUCCESS, which is providing study skills to students to prepare them to enter the Cambridge program. This will be an ongoing feature of our school, in collaboration with high school.
