Grant Purpose	The purpose of this grant is to provide an interactive, hands-on experience for all of our Kindergarten and grade one students in the area of literacy. Children will grow in their love of reading as they participate in the literacy program at InStride Therapy, Inc. The program offered is aligned with the ELA Common Core Standards.
Grant Activities	Students will visit the facility and participate in the literacy program "Reading with Little Red & Friends". There will be follow-up with a take home book as well as reading and writing activities in the classroom. Two classes will attend per session as to allow the children to enjoy the hands-on experience.
Grant Budget Items	The budget includes transportation and charge per student for the experience. The cost for busses is 2,625.00 and admission for 255 students is 1,350.00.
After Grant Plans	Students will continue to correspond to Little Red (the pony at the stable) as teachers provide opportunities to foster the love of reading and writing. There is a take home photo book that each student will receive to keep. Reference and research work can be presented about the horses.
