Grant Purpose	The purpose of this grant is to improve STEM related opportunities at North Port High School and Venice High School, and to create a sustainable model for the entire school district. By using engaging technology and developing strong career academies, student achievement levels and career focus will improve.
Grant Activities	Purchase TI-Nspire calculators for use in all Algebra, Geometry and Biology classrooms. Train teachers in the use of the calculators. Provide professional development in standard based instruction and interdisciplinary program development. Provide a lead teacher at each school to facilitate improved use of calculators. Provide summer camps for eight graders in STEM related activities.
Grant Budget Items	Purchase of TI-Nspire calculators and associated tools. Contracts for teachers providing training, participating in training and curriculum development. Contracts for lead teachers. Material and supplies for training.
