Proposed Changes to Walking Descriptions

ENGLEWOOD ELEMENTARY:

From the Gulf of Mexico at the northern tip of Manasota Kay, east to the drainage canal south of Ponderosa Road. East along the canal to State Road 776. South to the storm water pond south of Pierce Drive. East through the pond to its end. South along the eastern property line of the Pennington Place subdivision to Lemon Bay, east on Belvidere Road, then Manasota Beach Road to State Road 776. From the junction of Manasota Beach Road and State Road 776 Manasota Beach Road, east on an imaginary line to Myakka River. South, southeast along Myakka River to the Sarasota/Charlotte County line. South along the Sarasota/Charlotte County line to the Gulf of Mexico. North to the northern tip of Manasota Key. Lemon Bay. North through Lemon Bay to Belvidere Road. Includes all of Manasota Key. Also includes that portion of Charlotte and Lee Counties as approved by the Charlotte, Lee and Sarasota County School Boards.

TAYLOR RANCH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL:

From I-75 at Border Road, east on Border Road to Jackson Road. (Both sides of Border Road and all streets with access from Border Road are included in Taylor Ranch. NOTE: This is true also for the portion of Border Road east of the Myakka River.) North on Jackson Road to Palm Drive. East on Palm Drive to its termination. Due east from the termination of Palm Drive to the Myakka River. South and southeast along Myakka River to a point due east of Manasota Beach Road. West from this point along an imaginary extension of Manasota Beach Road to Manasota Beach Road at the southeastern corner of the Pennington Place subdivision. North along the subdivision's property line to the eastern end of the storm water pond south of Pierce Drive. West through the pond to State Road 776. North to the drainage canal south of Ponderosa Road. West through the canal to the northern tip of Manasota Key. Belvidere Road. West on Belvidere Road to Lemon Bay. North through Lemon Bay to Alligator Creek. East and northeast along Alligator Creek to an imaginary extension of Alligator Creek to an imaginary extension of Havana Road. North on an imaginary extension of Havana Road to Rich Street. West on Rich Street to an imaginary extension of Rich Street to Jacaranda Boulevard. (Both sides of Rich Street to Taylor Ranch). North on Jacaranda Boulevard to I-75. North on I-75 to Border Road. Also includes the area bounded on the east by the Sarasota/Charlotte County line, the south and west by the Myakka River, and the north by the city limits of North Port.
