

Here are two examples of possible tracks students can pursue in Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment:

Alexis is planning to attend a Florida university and has focused on Dual Enrollment courses. She completed her junior year with 10 DE classes to equal 30 college credits, and 30 credits as a full-time student at SCF her senior year. This totals 60 college credits! In addition, Alexis took 2 AP classes and, based on her AP exams, could earn more college credits.

James is planning to attend a university outside of the state of Florida and has focused on Advanced Placement courses. He completed 9 AP classes, 2 DE classes and completed the four year STEM series in Engineering. If James scores successfully on all of his AP exams, he could earn a minimum of 27 college credits, in addition to the 6 credits that he earned from Dual Enrollment. This totals 33 college credits!

Alexis and James are poised to apply to highly competitive universities and **both** will be successful in applying to colleges in-State and out-of-State. Each will enter with one to two years of college completed - **Tuition Free!**

DUAL ENROLLMENT & ADVANCED PLACEMENT



The North Port High School Collegiate Academy is an educational opportunity for NPHS students to earn up to two years of college credit

while simultaneously earning a high school diploma from North Port High School. During this accelerated college program, high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors will take Dual Enrollment **and/or** Advanced Placement courses on the North Port High School campus. These courses will satisfy the requirements for both the high school diploma and freshman and sophomore years of college.

This program is designed for students who have the maturity and discipline needed to handle the academic rigor of a college program while still in high school. It provides the opportunity for students to qualify for the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program as a Florida Academic Scholar or a Florida Medallion Scholar.

A NPHS student can complete their freshman and sophomore years of college for free. This course of study could potentially save \$10,534 in tuition alone at a Florida University.

Advanced Placement provides students with an opportunity for learning that goes beyond just facts and figures. The rich course material, classroom discussions and demanding assignments typical of AP courses will help students develop the content mastery and critical thinking skills expected of college students. What's more, by participating in AP, students have the opportunity to earn college credits and to stand out in the college admission process. College credits are earned based on scoring a 3, 4, or 5 on the AP exam. AP also helps students qualify for scholarships - 31 percent of colleges and universities look at AP experience when determining scholarships. **Advanced Placement courses offered at NPHS:**
