The main mission of the Bird Observatory is to get children outdoors, and connected to the natural world in a way that will enhance their education, fitness and mental health. Other benefits for our school include the beautification of a blighted area, a tool for the inspiration of creative lesson planning for teachers, and community connection between LNS and all the participants and funding sources involved in this renovation.

Laurel Nokomis School is a magnet school for children with autism. This garden area has an oval sidewalk where these students, as well as wheelchair-bound students will have unobstructed access to the garden.
