Grant Activities	The FDLRS Suncoast grant provides opportunities for developmental screenings for children age 3-5 years, Pre-K transition, child find, professional development, assistive technology, parent services, and IDEA implementation to Charlotte, Manatee and Sarasota Districts. A Florida Inclusion Network (FIN) Facilitator is also funded through the FDLRS Suncoast grant. The FIN facilitator works collaboratively to support student placement and achievement in the least restrictive environment
