ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA and COMMUNITY HAVEN FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES, INC. D/B/A SELBY PRESCHOOL

THIS ADDENDUM is entered into August 15, 2017, by and between The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida, a body corporate under the laws of the State of Florida (the "Board") and Community Haven for Adults and Children with Disabilities, Inc., d/b/a Selby Preschool ("Selby Preschool").

RECITALS

- A. The parties hereto entered into a contract for educational services for eligible exceptional students (the "Contract") on July 18, 2017, expiring June 30, 2018, for services through May 2018.
- B. The parties hereto desire to modify the Contract to update the matrix and total reimbursement amounts and to provide compensation therefor under the following terms and conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises made herein, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 3D of the Contract is amended to include the updated matrix amounts with the current base student allocation as follows:

Matrix 251 - \$ 5,447.64

Matrix 252 - \$ 7,190.98

Matrix 253 - \$10,475.37

Matrix 254 - \$14,616.71

Matrix 255 - \$22,318.86

2. Paragraph 3D of the Contract is further amended to increase the total compensation for all services, as amended to read: "Total reimbursement under this Contract for all services shall not exceed \$133,987.12."

3. The parties acknowledge and agree that the remainder of the terms of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect during the term of this Addendum.

4. Where there is any conflict between the terms of this Addendum and the Contract, the terms of this Addendum shall control.
