Venice YMCA School Age Child Care Programs 2011/2012 *updated 07/01/11

Registrations fees per child *Non-refundable/Non-transferable* August-December \$30.00 January-March \$20.00 April-May \$10.00

Option 1: Year Round Program Includes after school care, before school care (Garden, Taylor Ranch, Venice Christian-K-5th), Venice El. & Venice Middle school days off, holiday camps and summer day camp of 2011. Registration forms and fees (if applicable) are required. Fees: Member bank draft rate \$190.00 Non Member bank draft rate \$220.00 *non draft rates \$200/\$230

Option 2: School Year Only Includes after school care, before school care (Garden, Taylor Ranch, Venice Christian-K-5th), Venice El and Venice Middle, school days off and holiday camps. Registration forms and fees (if applicable) are required. Fees: Member bank draft rate \$175.00 Non Member bank draft \$205.00 *non draft rates \$185/\$215

Option 3: Before School Care ONLY This care is for children who attend Garden, Taylor Ranch, Venice Christian-(K-5th) and Venice El. Fees: Member bank draft rate \$45.00 Non Member bank draft \$60.00 *non draft rates \$55/\$70

Option 4: Full Day Programs These include teacher work days, winter and spring break camps. ADVANCED REGISTRATION is required for these days with completed registration card, registration fee, permission slip for the actual day and daily fee. Fees: Member \$15.00 per day Non Member \$20.00 per day

Venice Middle School Rates-Before School Only

Fees: Member bank draft rate \$55.00 Non Member bank draft \$60.00 *non draft rates \$65/\$70

Payments are accepted electronically via checking, savings or credit/debit card accounts. Any delinquent accounts will result in termination from the program. Scholarship applications are available at the YMCA front desk.
