Grant Purpose	Florida Studio Theatre invites the students and educators on an integrative, positive exploration of playwriting. This series of workshops led by Florida Studio Theatre professional Teaching Artists meets core curriculum standards in Language Arts and can be custom designed to coincide with Social Studies benchmarks. This project will incorporated cooperative groups, reading and writing skills, and speaking and listening skills.
Grant Activities	Florida Studio Theatre professional Teaching Artists will work with the classroom teacher to identify themes and topics using Social Studies curriculum. Examples of topics that may be selected include: Ponce de Leon and the exploration of Florida, the Florida Railroad, which would include Henry Flagler and Henry Plant, and the development of Cape Canaveral. Students will work under the guidance of FST staff in cooperative groups to create and perform plays on these topics.
Grant Budget Items	This grant will be used to fund nine workshops for four classes, for a total of 36 workshops conducted by FST's Teaching Artists.
