Grant Purpose	The grant's purpose is to introduce students to basic rhythms and techniques of hand percussion and drumming found in other cultures. Students will learn that music is a way to communicate, and just as written communication, has developmental form. They will learn musical elements and characteristics of the Afro-Cuban and Afro-Caribbean music. Students will begin to develop a respect, and appreciation of different musical styles as they make cultural connections through hands-on experiences.
Grant Activities	Students will be involved with Ed-Explore teaching artist, Scott Blum and his program "Elements of Afro-Cuban and Afro-Caribbean Percussion". They will learn basic rhythms, techniques and poly-rhythms of the cultures. Students will use a variety of instruments including hand percussion and drums, as well as sticks with trash cans, paint buckets, and drums! They will perform demonstrating various musical expressive elements. Students will analyze and critique their performances.
Grant Budget Items	Grant funds will be used to pay for the Ed-Explore Experience directly involving the entire 5th grade population. Instruments will be purchased that will be used by all students at other grade levels, as well, in the introductory and extended activities. A small portion will be used for contracted services for a performer to come into the school.
After Grant Plans	At the end of the grant period, the school music teacher will extend the percussion and drumming techniques through appropriate activities for students in grades 3 and 4, as well. An after-school drumming program will also be offered.
