School Board of Sarasota County Sarasota County Health Department Contract

This Agreement is made and entered into this 10th day of December 2002, by and between the School Board of Sarasota County, Florida a body corporate under the laws of the State of Florida ("School Board") and the State of Florida, Department of Health, Sarasota County Health Department ("SCHD").

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the School Board and SCHD hereby agree as follows:

I. The SCHD agrees:

- A. To provide Senior Community Health Nurses in each public, non-ESE centered high school. See attached job description.
- B. Shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, rules and ordinances of the federal government, state, county, local agency, or government, including but not limited to, licensure requirements and continuing education requirements.
- C. Shall provide the Board quarterly financial statements during the period of this Agreement with requests for payment in accordance with Section II, paragraph B below.
- D. SCHD, as a state agency or subdivision, as defined in section 768.28, Florida Statutes, agrees to be fully responsible to the limits set forth in section 768.28, Florida Statutes, for its negligent acts or omissions or intentional tortuous acts which result in claims or suits against the School Board, and agrees to be liable to the limits set forth in section 768.28, Florida Statutes, for any damages proximately caused by said acts or omissions. Nothing herein shall be construed to be a waiver of sovereign immunity by SCHD to which sovereign immunity applies. Nothing herein shall be construed as consent by a state agency or subdivision of the State of Florida to be sued by third parties in any matter arising out of any contract. SCHD agrees that it is an independent contractor of the School Board and not agent or employee of <u>Sarasota</u> County School Board.
- E. Shall ensure that its employees assigned hereunder have been fingerprinted by an authorized law enforcement agency and processed by the State Department of Law Enforcement and the Federal Bureau of Investigation for criminal background checks. The results of all such background investigation and fingerprinting will be reported in writing to the School Board's Superintendent of Schools.

II. The School Board agrees:

- A. To pay SCHD the sum of seventy thousand (\$70,000.00) dollars in exchange for the services provided herein.
- B. Shall remit, upon receipt of required financial statements and requests for payment, total compensation not to exceed \$70,000.00 for the period from January 1, 2003 to

December 30, 2003. The total compensation shall be payable in four installment payments due on March 30, June 30, September 30, and December 30, 2003 as pursuant to invoices submitted.

Both Parties agree:

- A. That the SCHD is an independent contractor and neither it nor any of its supervisors, employees, aides, or any other persons utilized by the SCHD in providing the Services under this Agreement shall be deemed an employee, servant, or agent of the School Board.
- B. The parties shall recognize and safeguard the confidential nature of case records and student information in conformance with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations, and both Parties' policies pertinent to the right of privacy of parents. guardians, and students.
- C. The Parties shall each consent to all notices, informational pamphlets, press releases, research reports, and other similar public notices prior to publication and release.
- D. The respective personnel of each Party shall communicate and exchange appropriate client information in a manner consistent with Florida Statutes, Department of Health rules, School Board rules, and professional regulations.
- E. Any alterations, variations, modifications, or waivers of this Agreement shall only be valid when they have been placed in writing, signed, and attached to this Agreement. Both parties agree to renegotiate this Agreement if Federal or State revision of any applicable laws or regulations should occur. This Agreement may be amended at any time, in writing, by mutual notice and approval of both parties.
- F. Both Parties shall comply with the provisions of Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all other Federal Laws applicable to equal employment opportunity.
- G. This Agreement contains all terms and conditions agreed upon by the Parties. No other agreements, oral or otherwise, regarding the subject matter of this Agreement shall be deemed to exist or to bind any of the Parties hereto.
- H. This Agreement shall commence January 1, 2003 or on the date the Agreement has been signed by both parties, whichever is later, and continue from year to year unless terminated in writing by either party at the close of a school year.
- I. Any notice given pursuant to this Agreement shall be made as follows:
