

**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE SCHOOL BOARD OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA AND  
ASSOCIATED MARINE INSTITUTE, INC.  
GULF COAST MARINE INSTITUTE-SOUTH, INC.**

This Amendment to Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_ day of August, 2007, between The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida, a body corporate under the laws of the State of Florida (the "School Board") and Associated Marine Institute, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation ("AMI"), which operates a program known as Gulf Coast Marine Institute-South, Inc. ("GCMI");

**WHEREAS**, the School Board and AMI entered into an Agreement dated July 15, 2003 ("Agreement") concerning the GCMI program; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to modify their Agreement to include the provision described below.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, and other valuable consideration, the parties to this Amendment to Agreement hereby agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 6.3 of the Agreement shall be amended to read, in its entirety:

AMI shall develop a School Improvement Plan in compliance with F.S. 1001.42(16) and 1003.53(2)(b) and in the format prescribed by the School Board. AMI shall be responsible for meeting student performance goals as defined in the School Improvement Plan for improving student achievement.

2. The parties acknowledge and agree that the remainder of the terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. Where there is any conflict between the terms of this Amendment and the Agreement, this Amendment shall control.
