As said funds are made available, the said Board proposes to carry out these projects as nearly as practicable in the order given, subject to changes as provided in state law and Florida Administrative Code.

Projects are placed in the proper category according to the following:

- I. <u>Completed</u> when a Certificate of Final Inspection has been issued, a project is placed in the completed category. This project will be eligible for the expenditure of state funds during the fiscal year in which the Certificate is issued and one additional fiscal year thereafter, after which, it should not be listed unless there are outstanding encumbrances. Completed projects should be identified only by Project Priority List (PPL) number and date of Certificate of Final Inspection.
- II. <u>Under Construction</u> when a contract or purchase order is executed for a project, the project is placed in the under construction category and remains there until the Certificate of Final Inspection is issued.
- III. <u>Planned</u> when projects are in the planning stage and State Board of Education approval is being requested so that state capital outlay funds may be expended on the projects, they are placed in the planned category.
- IV. <u>Deleted</u> when a project's source of funding has changed to other than that provided in accordance with provisions of Section (9)(d), Article XII, State Constitution, as amended, or projects are not under contract at the beginning of a New Five Year Educational Plant Survey.
