Grant Purpose	The objectives for Circus Physical Education! are for our fourth and fifth grade students to continue to improve their cardiovascular endurance as well as anaerobic strength through teamwork utilizing a circus performance theme provided by The Circus Arts Conservatory. The students will learn physical activity circus-themed disciplines through rotating stations as they provide team-building in their Physical Education class.
Grant Activities	. Each of the classes will have up to 55 students for four days of activities that will be taught by trained coaches from The Circus Arts Conservatory for 50 minutes. The activity stations consist of the following disciplines: simple acrobatics, mini trampoline, triple trapeze, low wire, upper body training, cardiovascular endurance, and manipulations (hula-hoop, spinning plates, juggling). Arts Conservatory coaches, the students will work in depth to improve the skill that they chose as well
Grant Budget Items	Five coaches from the Circus Arts Conservatory, all of the circus apparatus and safety equipment for 12 50 minutes stations for 4th and 5th grade students. 240 students @ \$18.00 each at the total cost of \$4,320
