ADDITIONAL SERVICES PROPOSAL FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THE ADDITION OF DECORATIVE AND CHAIN LINK SECURITY FENCING TO THE PINE VIEW CAMPUS

General project description:

The fencing design shall be based in information provided by the Owner's representative in the form of an exhibit which includes a partial site plan with labels articulating the principal features desired. This exhibit is attached at the end of this proposal and serves as a graphic program to guide the development of the security fencing design.

Design Services to include:

Determine emergency egress requirements in accordance with current code and design security fencing and gates as needed to satisfy emergency egress requirements and the Owner's goals for security fencing as shown in the attached exhibit.

Prepare drawings for the Owner's review of fencing locations and configuration.

Attend meetings to review the design with the Owner's representatives.

Revise layout of security fencing based on Owner's review.

Prepare drawings and specifications to be used for bidding, permitting and construction.

Electrical engineering services required to provide electrical power for two automatic gates and four access control personnel gates as per the attached exhibit will be provided by ME3 Consulting Engineers as a consultant to Seibert Architects. Other than the security cameras that may be included at the four access control gates, no other security cameras or related security conduits are included in this scope of work.

Respond to permit review comments as required as revise drawings and resubmit as required to obtain permit.

Construction Administration Services to include:

Reviewing submittals.

Answering questions and RFIs pertaining to the requirements of the contract documents.

Reviewing the work in progress and at completion to verify substantial compliance with the construction documents.

Preparation and submittal of close out documents based on the Contractor's mark-ups.

Exclusions and qualifications:

The Architect's services shall be limited to tasks outlined in this proposal. In no case shall the Architect provide services normally performed by Consulting Engineers or others. As such, Survey work, Geotechnical services, Landscape design, Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering, if required, shall be provided by others.

All structural engineering required for fencing and gates shall be provided by others as part of the submittal requirements for those elements.

The Architect shall rely on the accuracy of the survey provided by the Owner. In no case shall the Architect be held responsible for discrepancies between the survey and existing conditions. If discrepancies become known to the Architect which have a material effect on the design of the fencing, the Architect shall advise the Owner of such. Additional work resulting from an inaccurate survey shall be compensated for as an additional service.

Payment:

Professional fees for the services outlined above total \$24,715, including the services provided by ME3. These services are to be provided as an amendment to our original agreement, dated September 2, 2014. The terms and conditions of that original agreement will apply equally to the work outlined in this proposal.
