

The news release also informs applicants of the availability of an orientation session and district technical assistance.

April 28, 2010 3:00-4:30 PM Room 220 Blue Awning Building Orientation and Training Session for ALL potential Charter School applicants.

This session is a highly-recommended district meeting for applicants. A make-up session may be scheduled as needed no later than July 15 for those unable to attend the April 28th session. Training will include content from School Board staff representing all of the areas of specialization required for charter operation.
