## PROFESSIONAL ETHICS

6.27\*

- I. <u>An effective educational program requires the services of personnel of integrity, high</u> ideals, and human understanding. All employees shall be expected to maintain and promote these qualities. The Board shall also expect all administrative, instructional and support staff members to adhere to the *Code of Ethics of the Education Profession in Florida* and the *Principles of Professional Conduct for the Education Profession in Florida*.
- II. <u>Administrative and instructional personnel, as defined by Florida Statute, shall be</u> required to complete training on these ethical standards. All other employees shall be encouraged to participate in training related to professional ethics.
- III. <u>All employees shall be responsible for reporting misconduct by School Board employees</u> that affects the health, safety or welfare of a student.
