BUILDING CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGY

CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT:

1. The student must enroll and be admitted to MCC in the Program of Study leading to an Associate in Applied Science degree in Building Construction Technology, within two (2) calendar years from either graduation from high school or completion of the Drafting Program at the postsecondary adult vocational program.
2. The student makes application for CEL (Credit for Experiential Learning) credit with the Director of Occupational & Technical Education for the above courses. All CEL fees will be waived. **To meet CEL requirements for college equivalency credit the student must present a portfolio and pass MCC final exam for each of the courses for which credit is to be awarded.**
3. SCTI/MTI submits a transmittal form, signed by the Director, to the MCC records office indicating the competencies completed by the student.
4. The student has completed all other requirements for graduation.
5. Portfolio shall include at least 50% of manual board drafting.

The articulated credit will be placed on student's transcript upon completion of fifteen (15) semester hours of college credit courses.

REVIEW PROCESS:

This articulation agreement will be reviewed every two years unless superseded by a statewide articulation agreement.

Once initially established and appropriate approvals are secured, the Articulation Agreement shall remain in effect until revised or revoked. Sixty (60) days written notice must be given by either party to revoke an Articulation Agreement.
