- ✓ Credits will be placed on student's MCC transcript after student has completed 15 semester hours of MCC credits.

Criminal Justice Technology

In a continuing effort to provide seamless transition from secondary to post-secondary career ladder programs, and in accordance with the Carl D. Perkins Vocational Technology Amendments of 1990, Manatee Community College agrees to extend at no cost to the eligible students (other than the requisite application fee(s)) full college credit to those who have completed the **Correctional Officer** programs at the technical institutes and the Manatee and Sarasota County High Schools.

CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT:

1. The student must successfully complete the **Correctional Officer** at MTI or SCTI and pass all sections of the Certification Exam through Criminal Justice Standards and Training (CJSTC).
2. The student must meet dual entrance requirements for each school and program.
3. Both full-time and part-time faculty of articulated criminal justice courses must be certified as having met the criteria for academic and professional preparation established by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools for Manatee Community College.

Each full-time and part-time faculty member must possess appropriate academic preparation or academic preparation coupled with work experience. The minimum academic degree must be at the same level at which the faculty member is teaching.

4. Students who have successfully completed the required courses at SCTI or MTI and have an official transcript sent from SCTI or MTI to the MCC Criminal Justice Program Manager will be awarded a maximum of 21 hours credit (for MCC courses listed on page 1) toward the degree in **Criminal Justice Technology**.

5. The articulated credit will be placed on the student's transcript after admission to the program in Criminal Justice Technology and upon completion of fifteen (15) semester hours of college credit courses at Manatee Community College.
6. MCC graduates will get "preferential admission" to enter the Correctional Officer if the applicant meets the entrance requirements of the Academy.
7. The credit process is available to all students who have completed the Academy since the Certification Exam was enacted.

REVIEW PROCESS:

This articulation agreement will be reviewed every two years unless superceded by a statewide articulation agreement.

Once initially established and appropriate approvals are secured, the Articulation Agreement shall remain in effect until revised or revoked. Sixty (60) days written notice must be given by either party to revoke an Articulation Agreement.
