## Benchmark: AT - RISK Reports

Students are included on an At-Risk Report when their performance on a standard falls within the At-Risk or Below Basic category for the specific test.

## Benchmark Result Reports

The results are available at the district, school, teacher, class and student levels for comparison. Teachers can view their own classes and students. Administrators can view all teachers, classes and students for their school.

## EARLY WARNING High Risk Reports

## Early Warning Report

- Identify students early who demonstrate poor performance on specific key indicators which have been shown to correlate with At-Risk students.
- Reports will be available at the Elementary, Middle, and High School levels.
- Accessible at the district, school, grade, teacher, and student levels.
