- Clear Identification of at-risk students by several academic and behavioral indicators
- State and Local Assessment Reports displaying current state and local assessment data differentiated by level of performance and at-risk categories
- Benchmark Reports designed to improve instruction for all students
- Early Warning Report based on key performance indicators

At – Risk Report Views:

- Standards by Student View at-risk performance on specific standards, by student, highlighting each student's performance below expectations.
- Students by Standards View the standards assessed and which students did not meet expectations on each standard.
- Subgroups by Standards View below expectation performance standards by demographic subgroups.

Early Warning Report

- Identify students <u>early</u> who demonstrate poor performance on specific key indicators which have been shown to correlate with At-Risk students.
- Reports will be available at the Elementary, Middle, and High School levels.
- Accessible at the district, school, grade, teacher, and student levels.
