Grant Purpose	The University of Florida has been awarded a grant from the US Department of Education through the Supporting Effective Educator Development (SEED) program to provide professional development to teachers in grades K-9 in a train-the-trainer model for development of

	highly qualified STEM teachers. Goals include improved student learning outcomes and enhanced teacher content knowledge and pedagogy.
Grant Activities	Participating teachers will be randomly placed into participant or control groups by the external evaluator and will be compensated by the grant for their participation and satisfying various requirements to be outlined by the project's Principal Investigators.
Grant Budget Items	Up to \$2,500 per year will be provided to the district in exchange for provision of data regarding the effectiveness of teachers participating in the project. Participating teachers can also earn payments for their participation and meeting project goals and deadlines.
After Grant Plans	Trained teachers will continue to use knowledge learned during the grant with future students.
