ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN MANATEE COMMUNITY COLLEGE and MANATEE & SARASOTA COUNTY TECHNICAL INSTITUTES and THE SCHOOL BOARDS OF MANATEE AND SARASOTA COUNTIES

Criminal Justice Technology

In a continuing effort to provide seamless transition from secondary to post-secondary career ladder programs, and in accordance with the Carl D. Perkins Vocational Technology Amendments of 1990, Manatee Community College agrees to extend at no cost to the eligible students (other than the requisite application fee(s) full college credit to those who have completed the Law Enforcement programs at the technical institutes and the Manatee and Sarasota County High Schools.

CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT:

- The student must successfully complete the Basic Recruit Law Enforcement Program at MTI or SCTI, pass all sections of the State Certification Exam through Criminal Justice Standard and Training (CJSTC).
- 2. The student must meet entry requirements of the College and be admitted as a student in good standing (this is done through the Admissions Office).
- 3. The student must have an official transcript sent from MTI/SCTI to the Criminal Justice Program Manager where a file will be kept of the student.
- 4. Eighteen (18) credit hours will be awarded and placed on the student's transcript after:
 - a. admission to the program. This requires successful completion of MAT 1033 or equivalent, ENC 1101, and CCJ 1020.
 - b. Successful completion of 15 credit hours of college coursework at Manatee Community College. This may include those program admission courses noted above.
- 5. The credit process is available to all students who have completed the Academy since the Certification Exam was enacted.

REVIEW PROCESS:

This articulation agreement will be reviewed every two years unless superceded by a statewide articulation agreement.

Once initially established and appropriate approvals are secured, the Articulation Agreement shall remain in effect until revised or revoked. Sixty (60) days written notice must be given by either party to revoke an Articulation Agreement.
