Construction Department decided to begin updating boundary surveys at all schools which was not anticipated during time of award.

Increase the purchasing limit of the Pesticide Treatment and Maintenance Services for Athletic Fields bid awarded on June 2, 2015 for \$200,000.00 - ncrease from \$200,000,00 to \$325,000.00.	\$ 125,000.00	The rental of and the resultant overuse of our athletic fields caused more wear and tear to our fields which required more fields to be resodded than expected.
4/15/2016	Facilities	Jon F. Swift, Inc., and Mailloux and Sons, Inc.	Increase the purchasing limit of the Carpentry Services - Time and Materials bid awarded on June 2, 2015 for \$250,000 - increase from \$250,000.00 to \$350,000.00	\$ 100,000.00	Facilities was asked to support the IT Department's goal of replacing their Active Boards which required us to utilize these vendors for replacement of damaged white boards and repair of damaged walls which were damaged from the installation and removal of the old Active Boards.
5/24/2016	Facilities	Gator Grading & Paving, LLC	Increase the purchasing limit of the Asphalt Paving Services bid awarded on January 20, 2015 for \$300,000.00 - increase from \$300K to \$700K	\$ 400,000.00	Due to the extreme deterioration of some larger asphalt projects the scope of work had to be increased more than expected because we were unable to overlay the asphalt as expected and was forced to go down to bare limerock base and completely repave these projects.
