

East Side:

Install the following (x9) Sch 40 posts:

- (x5) 32 ½" x 3" dia posts with 6" sq base plates
- (x1) 12' x 2" dia posts with a 3" x 6" base plate
- (x1) 12' x 3" dia posts with 6" sq base plate
- (x2) 26" x 3" dia posts with 6" sq base plates and 4" h x 4 1/2" w wings

Replace (x7) 46" wide a (x2) 13" wide 1 5/8" horizontal rails, replace (x4) end rail clamps and (x12) line clamp rails.

West Side:

Replace (x1) 46" wide and (x2) line clamp rails.

South Side:

- (x3) 12' x 3" dia posts with 6" sq base plate.
- (x2) line clamp rails.

North Side:

- (x2) 12' x 3" dia posts with 6" sq base plate.
- (x2) line clamp rails.

Base plate will have neoprene buffers and will be fastened to the slab with S.S. ½" x 3" sleeve anchors.

New posts will be attached to old posts with SS nut and bolt.
