Grant Purpose	The proposed project includes a performance-based residency using the drama-based anti-bullying program from drama teaching artist Hedda Matza-Haughton, LCSW. Students will use the technique of Improvisational Drama to explore the issue of bullying, incorporating English Language Arts standards into the acting, writing and communication skills of the project. This residency will support students' social and emotional development by providing an increased awareness of bullying.					
Grant Activities	The grant will used to fund classroom sessions from the teaching artist in order to create three performances. Students will explore the issue of bullying in schools as the artist introduces the technique of Improvisational Drama using improvisational games and skill-building activities. Students will have the chance to create characters in various bullying scenarios and perform them for the school, parents and community members.					
Grant Budget Items	The grant funds from the Education Foundation will be used fully to fund the artist in residence and her program. There are no necessary supplies involved in the project. The teaching artist will come onto the Fruitville Elementary campus to provide the classroom sessions, so no travel will be necessary.					
After Grant Plans	The proposed project will begin a school-wide dialogue about bullying. The involved students will have the opportunity to share their experiences with other students in the school and participate in activities such as the school-wide news program and classroom lessons to share the knowledge they gained from the program.
