Grant Purpose	The primary goal of Sarasota Against Violence (SAVE) is to reduce violence in the Newtown neighborhood by working with Booker Middle School students and their parents to understand the devastating effects of violence, teach students how to use non-violent ways to solve problems, and get students affected by violence the mental health services they need.
Grant Activities	Prevention Coordinator will help students find appropriate wrap-around services, will train guidance counselors in working with students to decrease violent behavior, and train other staff in how to identify students affected by violence. The Parent Liaison will work with parents to involve them in the school and support students. Barriers to participation in after-school programs will be facilitated with transportation and program scholarships.
Grant Budget Items	The district will contract with the Sarasota Coalition on Substance Abuse (SCOSA) for a Prevention Coordinator and part-time Parent Liaison; external evaluator; scholarships and transportation for BMS students to after-school programs.
After Grant Plans	The project's Steering Committee will seek outside funding to continue the positions and work begun with this grant.
