	Grant Purpose/Objective Information

Grant Purpose	A project to teach students with severe behavior problems how to react and participate in situations that involve bullying in a more socially appropriate way. (a decrease in physical and verbal aggressive behaviors and an increase in positive verbal and physical behaviors)
Grant Activities	Students will meet with artist-in-resident 2 times a week over four months and participate in improvisational drama activities to learn how to not be a bully, how to react more appropriate to bullies, and how to be a more appropriate bystander in a bullying situation. Students will then make up their own scenarios and act them out. The activities will culminate in a public presentation for other students at Oak Park and the 4th and 5th graders from Lakeview Elementary School.
Grant Budget Items	Artist-In-Resident Fee--\$5000 including all materials for the drama skits, etc. Meeting 2 times a week for four months culminating in a performance for other students in December.
After Grant Plans	Lessons learned during the Artist-in-Residence will continue during the daily social skills lessons that are required for these students.
