

- Sarasota County 21+ days absentee rate has decreased by 1.6 percentage points from SY 2008 to SY 2009.
- Sarasota County $21+$ days absentee rate is slightly less than surrounding counties of Manatee and Charlotte, and significantly less than Pinellas County.
