## AMENDMENT TO LINEAR PARK PROJECT AGREEMENT

This Amendment to Agreement dated February 1, 2000 (the "Linear Park Project Agreement") is by and among The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida (the "Board"), the Venice Area Beautification, Inc. ("VABI"), and the City of Venice, Florida (the "City").

**WHEREAS**, paragraph 5 of the Linear Park Project Agreement called for the Board to grant an easement to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to formalize the easement (including a slight modification to the legal description).

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the premises and the covenants herein contained, the Board, the City and VABI do mutually covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. The easement referenced in paragraph 5 of the Linear Park Project Agreement shall be granted in the form attached hereto (the "Pedestrian Easement").
- 2. The sketch and legal description attached as Exhibit "3" to the Linear Park Project Agreement are superseded by the sketch and legal description attached to the Pedestrian Easement.
- 3. Except as modified by this Amendment, all of the terms and provisions of the Linear Park Project Agreement are hereby ratified and declared to be in full force and effect.

## PEDESTRIAN EASEMENT

THIS EASEMENT is made by and between THE SCHOOL BOARD OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA, a body politic under the laws of the State of Florida (the "School Board"), and the CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, a municipal corporation (the "City").

**WHEREAS,** the School Board, the City, and Venice Area Beautification, Inc. previously enter into an agreement dated February 1, 2000 (the "Agreement") regarding a linear park project (the "Project") on the campus of Venice High School; and

**WHEREAS**, paragraph 5 of the Agreement states that the School Board shall grant a non-exclusive easement to the City related to the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration, the School Board does hereby grant unto the City a non-exclusive easement over that portion of the Property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto (the "Easement Areas"), for the purpose of pedestrian usage on the pathways constructed and maintained by the City within the Easement Areas, and maintenance by the City of the Project and related improvements and appurtenances.

This easement grant is made by the School Board and accepted by the City subject to the following conditions by which the City covenants and agrees to abide:

- 1. This is a non-exclusive easement, with the School Board reserving unto itself, its successors and assigns, the right to the continued free use and enjoyment of the Easement Areas, for any purposes which are not inconsistent with the rights granted unto the City.
- 2. The City acknowledges that the School Board may in the future elect to reconfigure its campus. The School Board, therefore, reserves the right to relocate the easement in the event of such a reconfiguration, provided the School Board pays all costs of relocating the easement, and that the width of the easement is approximately the same width of the easement granted herein. Once the easement has been relocated: (a) the description of the easement property set forth in Exhibit "A" shall be amended to conform to the relocated easement, which amendment shall be evidenced by instrument executed by the parties and recorded in the Public Records of Sarasota County, Florida; and (b) the City (and the public) shall abandon use of the original Easement Areas.


3. Pursuant to the Agreement, the City agrees to maintain at its sole cost and expense the Easement Areas and all Project improvements and appurtenances.


