
# On the Mark Assessment: Concepts of Print Entering Kindergarten Met Benchmark Pre Test compared to Post Test




# FAIR Reading Comprehension Transition from End of Kindergarten (Spring) to Beginning of Grade 1 (Fall)



#### Reading Wonders: Fluency Probe Grade 2 Students Met Benchmark Pre Test compared to Post Test




# Standards Based Math Assessment: Counting & Cardinal Numbers Entering Kindergarten Met Benchmark Pre Test compared to Post Test


