

Kindergarten Report Card Revisions for 2014-2015

- Change **Effort Grade Key** (page 2 of report card)
 - E = Excellent: Remains the same as before
 - G = Good: Participates much of the time. Completes class assignments and homework. Is attentive, motivated, and organized.
 - S = Satisfactory: Usually participates. Completes class assignments and homework. Is attentive.
 - N = Needs Improvement: Remains the same as before
 - NA = Not Assessed at this time (Only used for Music, Art, PE, or other Wheel classes where teachers may only see the students a limited number of times during the quarter and feel he/she cannot make an informed decision about a student's effort.)
- **Effort grade** assigned remains the same (It is given all 4 quarters for all content areas.)
- Change **Performance Grade Key** title to Performance Standards Grade Key
(Added words End of Year to each grade key)
 - 4 = Exceeds End of Year Standard: The student independently exceeds grade level concepts and skills with high quality work reflecting higher thinking skills.
 - 3 = Meets End of Year Standard: Remains the same as before
 - 2 = Progressing toward End of Year Standard: Remains the same
 - 1 = Beginning Demonstration of End of Year Standard: Remains the same as before
 - NA = Not Assessed at This Time
- **Performance grade key** - NA (Not assessed at this time) may be used during **Quarter 1 for Language Arts ONLY** when a teacher feels he/she has not sufficiently addressed the instructional process for specific report card standards. In **ALL other subjects** it will be up to the teacher to determine if NA is appropriate each quarter based on the same criteria shown above for Language Arts. Once a teacher assesses a student's performance on a standard, the teacher must continue to evaluate progress each quarter thereafter. At no point should NA be used beyond quarter 3. If used in quarter 3, it should be used only in limited circumstances.

- Change Responsibilities of the Learner, list as shown below:

Stays focused.

Works independently.

Is responsible for belongings and materials.

Completes tasks in a reasonable time.

Shows best effort.

Attends school regularly and comes to class on time.

Is respectful to others.

Completes homework on time.

Works well with others.

Remove Grade 2-5 information.

Change – Add the word Standard to Performance Grade Key title- (Performance Standards Grade Key)

Change – Under Report Card format substitute Common Core State Standards with Florida Standards.
