Grant Purpose	To address access and equity to arts with students with disabilities we will: 1) Train teachers responsible for the daily instruction of students with disabilities to integrate arts into daily lessons; and 2) Train arts teachers to create an inclusive environment, ensuring students with disabilities actively participate in arts classes. Our goals are 1) make ESE teachers more confident in their implementation of arts integrated instruction, and 2) make arts teachers more confident in adapting t
Grant Activities	Training is expected to occur through workshops tentatively scheduled for June 2017 in conjunction with the Arts Integration League Summer Intensive. Follow-up sessions during the school year will allow further exploration and collaboration among participants. Areas of PD will include information for teachers about setting up an inclusive classroom, classroom management, building classroom culture, as well as differentiating instructional practices for students with disabilities.
Grant Budget Items	A \$5,000 grant from The Fine Arts Society will pay educators to develop specialized curriculum for ESE/arts teachers attending the summer workshop (\$400), hire professional (National) Teaching Artists to provide a two-day workshop (\$2,800 including expenses) and

	additional (local) Teaching Artists to facilitate specialized break-out sessions during the June workshop (\$1,000), and purchase supplies and materials for the workshops (\$800).
After Grant Plans	AGC-Sarasota will work with the ESE department to identify internal funds which can support additional and follow-up training for teachers of students with disabilities. AGC-Sarasota will continue to work with local and national foundations to expand this program.
