	Grant Purpose/Objective Information

Grant Purpose	This grant will provide funds to strengthen Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs in the three targeted schools (Booker, North Port and Venice High Schools). To support the schools' Applied Engineering Technology, Hospitality Management and Allied Health Assisting Career Academies, stronger ties will be forged with Institutions of Higher Education (IHE: Sarasota County Technical Institution and State College of Florida), Suncoast Workforce and local employers.
Grant Activities	To meet the needs of local employers and help students gain college- and career-required skills, CTE Connect will recruit IHE and employers to provide input to curricula development which will integrate industry-specific skills into regular classroom activities. Students will gain access to industry-based mentors, internships and other experiences, and will earn industry certifications and post-secondary credits while in high school.
Grant Budget Items	Grant funds will be used to hire a Program Director and three Career Pathways Advisors (one for each Academy), as well as for an external evaluator and staff time in the Research, Assessment and Evaluation office for data analysis. Funds will also pay for student certification exams, bus passes and transportation, marketing materials, educational experts, substitute teachers, staff development supplements and fringe benefits.
After Grant Plans	Teachers will be trained, processes and procedures will be in place, and relationships will already be established, so focus will be on maintaining these in the future with existing staff.
