The purpose of the grant it to work with teachers in grades 5-12 providing American History content, reading and writing strategies that are grade appropriate and will provide a vehicle for increasing the number of students ready and eligible for AP and DE History courses. High school teachers will be provided with teaching strategies to support non traditional AP and DE students and access to content and courses to make more teachers eligible to teach AP and DE Courses.

In addition, they will attend at least 3 book study sessions after school in the fall or spring and summer institutes to learn age appropriate strategies for reading, interpreting, discussing and writing in preparation for AP and DE courses in American History. Teachers will work in historic settings and with local and national primary source documents and artifacts.
