ADDENDUM TO RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA RE: STATUS OF DESIGNATED 1958 BUILDINGS ON THE CAMPUS OF RIVERVIEW HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida (the "Board"), as the governing body of the Sarasota County School District, agreed to have the National Trust for Historic Preservation facilitate a meeting with key stakeholders regarding the future of designated 1958 buildings on the campus of Riverview High School designed by architect Paul Rudolph; and

WHEREAS, the Board passed a Resolution agreeing to hold in abeyance any demolition of the wings making up the courtyard of the 1958 buildings until March 15, 2008 - specifically the two classroom wings, the auditorium, and part of the cafeteria (the "designated buildings"); on April 27, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution gave Revive Rudolph's Riverview, or its successor in interest, until March 15, 2008, to present to the Board certain documentation and information under paragraph 3 of said Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to modify its Resolution by extending the March 15, 2008 deadline until April 30, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida, in public meeting assembled that:

1. The March 15, 2008 date in paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Resolution are both extended to April 30, 2008.

2. The remainder of the Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Addendum to the Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
