ROTARY FUTURES COLLEGE RESOURCE CENTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN ROTARY FUTURES COLLEGE RESOURCE CENTER AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA

This Agreement, effective January 1, 2013, is made by and between Rotary Futures College Resource Center, Inc., a Florida corporation, c/o Andrew J. Britton, P.A., 401 Johnson Lane, Suite 102, Venice, Florida 34285 ("RFC") and The School Board of Sarasota County, Florida, 1960 Landings Boulevard, Sarasota, Florida 34231, ("School Board"), for and in consideration of one dollar and 00/100 (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged;

WITNESSETH

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Agreement is to delineate the relationship and responsibilities of RFC and the School Board regarding the Venice Rotary Futures College Resource Center operated on the Venice High School campus.

A. Responsibilities of RFC:

- (i) RFC shall provide a Program Director for sixty (60) months commencing on January 1, 2013. The Rotary Futures College Resource Center provides services to Venice High School students and other people in the community, as described in Exhibit A attached hereto.
- (ii) RFC shall pay to its Program Director an amount sufficient to cover all salary, benefits and other costs arising from and based upon the schedule of benefits attached hereto as Exhibit B. In no event shall RFC be responsible for or required to pay any funds, to the School Board or otherwise, in addition to those set forth on Exhibit B.
- (iii) The parties acknowledge that all funding for the Rotary Futures College Resource Center and the Program Director is provided by RFC through its fund raising efforts. In no event shall the School Board be obligated or required to pay any money for the Program Director or the services to be provided in Exhibit A, except for school supplies, phones and maintenance contracts.

B. Responsibilities of School Board:

(i) The program will run under the direction of the Principal and under the umbrella of the Board of Directors of the Rotary Futures College Resource Center. The Principal of Venice High School shall communicate with RFC regarding operational matters which, in the Principal's judgment,

will, or may, have a significant impact on the effective accomplishment of the services described in Exhibit A.

- (ii) The School Board will be responsible for any injuries or damages which result from any defective condition on or in the premises and RFC will be responsible for any injuries or damages which result from any negligent or intentional act taken by its employees or agents. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to waive any sovereign immunity to which the School Board is entitled under Florida law.
- 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Agreement shall be deemed effective as of January 1, 2013, and remain in effect through December 31, 2018, unless otherwise terminated by any one of the parties hereto.
- 3. <u>Amendment; Termination.</u> This Agreement may be modified only with the written consent of the parties hereto. Any party hereto may terminate this agreement at any time without cause upon written notice at least thirty (30) days in advance of the desired date of the cancellation.

Rotary Futures College Resource Center Program Services

The Rotary Futures College Resource Center (RFC) assists Venice-area students of all ages with post-secondary planning. RFC is run by trained professionals who with the help of volunteers assist students and community members at a center located prominently on the Venice High School campus very accessible to the public.

This center will have a broad base of responsibilities as outlined below:

- Counsel students of all ages on their post-secondary opportunities
- Advise students and parents individually and in group sessions on post-secondary planning
- Provide resources on colleges and technical schools
- Assist in applying to colleges and technical schools
- Set up SAT/ACT preparation programs
- Coordinate annual college fair for students in South Sarasota County
- Help find scholarship opportunities both locally and through the learning institutions
- Interface with scholarship donors and foundations
- Give financial aid assistance including filling out forms
- Communicate through internet, traditional newsletters, school bulletin boards, and the news media
- Give talks about RFC to community groups including business leaders
- Coordinate VHS students' community service registration and provide volunteering opportunities
- Organize VHS senior award program

The program will run under the direction of the Principal and under the umbrella of the Board of Directors of the Rotary Futures College Resource Center. The operating Board of Directors consists of 23 community members. Initially, RFC was funded by a grant from the Kathleen K. Caitlin Fund of the Community Foundation of Sarasota County. The major ongoing sponsorship comes from the Venice Nokomis Rotary Club, which accounts for one-third of the operating budget. The remainder of Rotary Futures funding comes from other community donations as well as fundraising by the Board of Directors.
