Thank you for giving us the opportunity to provide feedback on the Articulation Agreement. This is the first time t remember having the opportunity to read it and offer feedback.

Our daughter is a senior and is taking her 4th DE class now. She took 2 at the high school and 2 at SCF Venice. I can tell you that the information in this agreement should be made available to parents at the time classes are scheduled. This would have eliminated a lot of guesswork, frustration and running around by my daughter who this whole system is supposed to benefit. The voucher system for DE on the SCF Campus is *extremely* complicated. The procedure is laid out fairly well in this agreement but in practice it is very difficult and time consuming to navigate. I understand textbook costs have to be controlled and tracked but the burden of this is falling on the student. The guidance counselor has not been very helpful either. It seems like she doesn't fully understand the procedure. Our daughter and friends of hers last year have navigated the textbook labyrinth mostly by trial and error.
