

CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

EMERGENCIES

3.23

I. In case of an emergency involving the welfare and safety of students and employees, the Superintendent or designee may suspend any part of these regulations; provided, that he shall report the fact of and the reason for suspension at the next meeting of the School Board; and provided further, that the suspension shall expire at the time of such report unless continued in effect by actions of the School Board.

II. The following emergency response agency(ies) will notify the District in the event of an emergency:

III. In any case or condition not covered by these regulations, the Superintendent shall base the decision on his/her best judgment.
