

This project, Growing Toward Globalization, teaches our staff and students to better communicate with our Spanish speaking families. The materials we are purchasing, called Espanol para ti (McGraw Hill/WRA Wright Group), are a highly recommended, five-level, video-based system for teaching Spanish in the elementary grades. The project will enable the whole school to learn to speak Spanish and explore multi-cultural issues, broadening perspectives and instilling compassionate, empathetic points of view.		
Briefly list grant program activities (what is going to be done with the grant funds):		
This project will be implemented gradually over the next five years and will continue school-wide after that with the materials purchased during the start-up years. We have already purchased the first phase and are utilizing them in kindergarten classes as well as all of our AWC (Advanced Work Classes). It employs instructional materials developed and utilized successfully by elementary schools during the last decade. The program materials are called Español para ti.

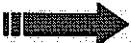
