WHAT IS A MULTI-TIERED SYSTEM OF SUPPORT (MTSS)?


Systemic Continuous Framework

Data based decision making and problem solving

Practiced across all levels-both academic and behavior

RTI & MTSS

• MTSS is the framework and Rtl is a part of this framework.



Response to intervention (RTI) is a framework that many schools use to help students who are struggling with academics. There are three levels of intervention in RTI.

Tier 3- Individualized

Tier 2- Small Group

Tier 1- Whole Group

- Through analysis of:
 - Early warning report
 - FSA results
 - iReady benchmark data
 - Discipline data
 - Attendance data
 - Grades
 - Project 10


