This purpose of this project is to emphasize that we are all individuals, and together we have something to contribute to the world.
Grant Activities	The book depicts "rock" fish that are unique from one another. Students and staff will paint individual rocks. Rocks will be placed outside in a garden. The proposed area requires extensive preparation to become a meaningful space. The garden will feature painted rocks, crushed shells, and a brick pathway. A sign will remind visitors that, "There's only one you in this great big world. Make it a better place." This project will accentuate the sense of community that exists at our school.
